**bagabaga:** emu chick From bagan (stripe)

**Dhaadhaa-gu**: Pop's

From Dhaadhaa (Pop, grandfather) + -gu

(belonging to)

**Yaadha**: day

From yaay (sun in Yuwaalaraay, the Gamila-

raay word is yaraay) + dha (at, in)

Gayaa: happy


**Bubaa:** Dad, father
